Hotspots

◎ NAMBUNG NATIONAL PARK

Home to a variety of native plants including wattles, Yellow Tailflower, White Clematis and Parrot Bush. Nambung National Park also hosts the iconic Pinnacles Desert, which is another reason to visit this unique National Park.

© LESUEUR NATIONAL PARK

Just a 15-minute drive from Jurien Bay, Lesueur National Park is a must-see for wildflower lovers and botanists with approximately 10% of Western Australia's known flora! And III species are endemic to the region. A few species you may encounter include Acacias, Hibbertias, Melaleucas and Orchids.

DEPOT HILL

5 minutes from Mingenew in the heart of wildflower country, Depot Hill boasts an abundance of wildflowers from blankets of everlastings to various unique species of orchids, it is the perfect picnic spot. Walk further along the bush track to discover the historic WW2 Army Rifle range.

CHAPMAN VALLEY

This charming agricultural town is a must-stop for Wildflower fans, with bright pink, blue and white everlastings that brighten the local landscape. The established scenic drives provide the perfect views from the comfort of your car, between Nanson and Yuna. Mills Lookout is a notable stop that offers spectacular views across Chapman Valley with species including Damperia, Grevillea Pinaster and Melalueca.

© KALBARRI NATIONAL PARK

Here you will find over 800 species of native flora with many of them being endemic to the region. Recommended locations include Hawks Head, Z-Bend Lookout, Mushroom Rock and Red Bluff. Some varieties you may encounter are the Murchison Rose, Murchison Magic Red Grevillea and the Kalbarri Spider Orchid, as well as many other orchid species. The Visitor Centre has a comprehensive wildflower guide available for \$1.

© COALSEAM CONSERVATION PARK

Located between Mingenew and Mullewa the Coalseam Conservation Park is renowned for its colourful carpets of Everlastings. You may also find other wildflower varieties such as banksias, hakeas, grevilleas and Yellow Pom Poms.

MULLEWA

Showcasing some of the best from Wildflower Country with multiple trails to explore both in the car and on foot. Mullewa delivers a great variety of everlasting species and orchids. The town also hosts the annual Outback Bloom Festival scheduled for the 22nd-25th of August 2024.

♥ PINDAR

Roughly 30 minutes outside of Mullewa, in the township of Pindar, you will find the rare and exquisite Wreath Leschenaultia (Wreath Flower). Keep your eyes peeled along the road heading into Pindar as this is where you may spot these rare gems.

© SHARK BAY WORLD HERITAGE AREA

Admire the contrasting colours of the landscape, enhanced by the blooming wildflowers. Travelling North of the homestead in Francois Peron National Park requires 4WD. There you may spot the Shark Bay Daisy (local icon), the Wild Rose (a crowd favourite), Dampiera's and Purple Peas.

© NINGALOO COAST WORLD HERITAGE AREA

This region encompasses Coral Bay, Carnarvon, Exmouth and the Cape Range National Park. The park alone has roughly 620 species of flowering plants! Ningaloo is most known for the purple Mulla Mulla but you can also spot wattles and the Minilya Lily found in the flat plains between Minilya and Lyndon River. Notable locations for views and wildflowers include Mandu Mandu Gorge, Shothole Canyon, Charles Knife Canyon and Yardie Creek Gorge. Further south you will find an array of wildflowers both in and around Carnarvon.



The trail takes you through the heart of Wildflower Country, and the regional towns of Coorow, Carnamah, Three Springs, Mingenew, Mullewa and the Chapman Valley.

You will have the opportunity to explore Geraldton, the Coalseam Conservation Park and Lesueur National Park. The trail showcases a collection of Western Australia's wildflowers from unique and rare orchids to blankets of everlastings coasting the countryside.

Everlastings Trail

As a wildflower favourite we've made it easy to find and follow the everlastings this wildflower season.

Kalbarri (With fortunate weather conditions, the region will burst into a kaleidoscope of colour over agricultural farmlands, hillsides, and along many roadsides. On this trail, you will explore Wildflower Country regional towns and wind up at picturesque Kalbarri. The colour palette for the everlastings found on this trail include variations of pinks, blues, white and yellow. Providing a remarkable sight of colours on top of an already beautiful landscape.

The Kalbarri National Park alone has roughly 800 species of native flora, many of which are endemic, including the coveted Kalbarri spider orchid. Make sure to stop into the visitor centre to obtain a thorough wildflower map for only \$1.

Travelling up the coast you will pass through Geraldton on your way to Kabarri where you will find the Kalbarri National Park. The park covers over 180,000 hectares and includes remarkable coastal cliffs and deep gorges where hundreds of unique species bloom, with many of them being endemic to the area.

Continuing North you will find yourself at Shark Bay and Francois Peron National Park. Here you may spot the local Shark Bay Daisy and many other incredible species of unique wildflower specimens. Venture further north and you'll find yourself in Carnarvon where you'll be rewarded with outstanding wildflower displays and blankets of seasonal everlastings. 

Embark on the ultimate journey exploring the region's incredibly unique and diverse wildflowers.


